Questions & Answers

1. Is KPS interested in trade-in of existing Cisco switches being removed from buildings?

Answer: Yes. If trade-in credit is offered, please provide this as a voluntary alternate. Please show the amount of credit offered for each building.

2. What models are available for trade-in?

Answer: Old switch models are mostly 2960S, 3560 and 3750 models. There are approximately 100 switches available to trade-in.

3. Please explain the total at the bottom of the table on sheet T301.

Answer: Because existing fiber and UTP patch cords and existing SX SFP units can be reused, this table calculates the number of new items you need to provide in your bid after accounting for reuse of existing items. For all other items not show in the table, use counts calculated off of the network diagram on sheet T303.

5. Will asset labels or other tracking labels be required on switches?
